General:

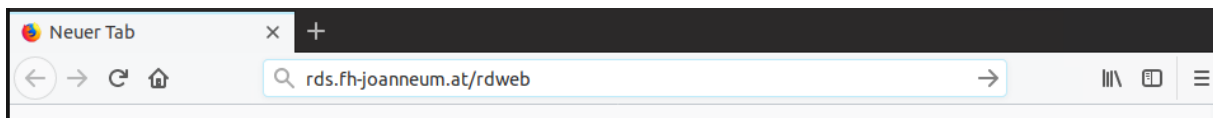
This service provides a desktop for teleworking on an external computer or private PC.

You have access to:

- Microsoft Office applications
- Online Administration (aCTIONS)
- SAP
- the personal network drive (Z:)
- the study and department network drives. (O:, P:, L:)

Remote Desktop Service connection:

- 1.) Start the Cisco AnyConnect client and connect to the FH network. For further information see <https://www.fh-joanneum.at/hochschule/services/helpdesk/vpn/>
- 2.) Start a web browser and open <https://rds.fh-joanneum.at/rdweb>.



- 3.) Enter your FH user credentials (technikum\username and password) and click on „Anmelden“.

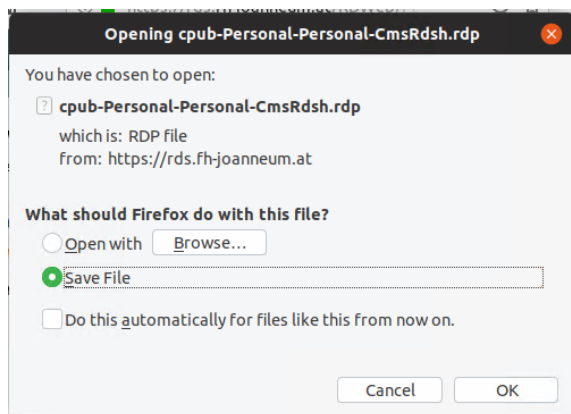

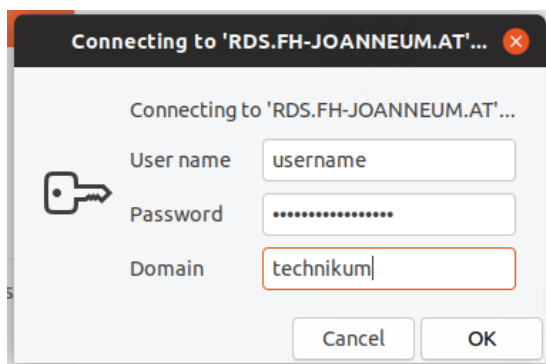


- 5.) Depending on your web browser configuration the RDP file may be opened or saved immediately or you could be asked how to proceed.
