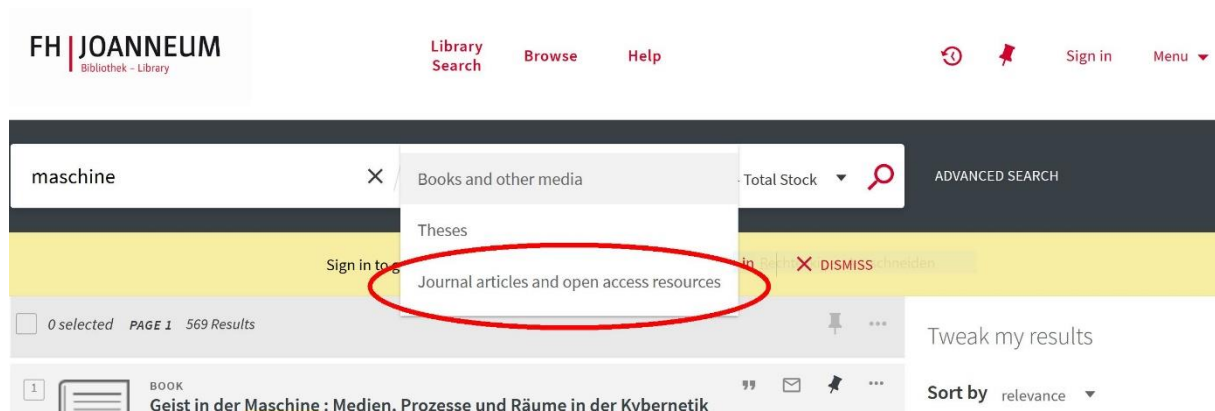
New search range „Theses“

This search range does not replace our databases but it offers a good first step towards numerous peer-reviewed journal articles and open access resources of high quality.

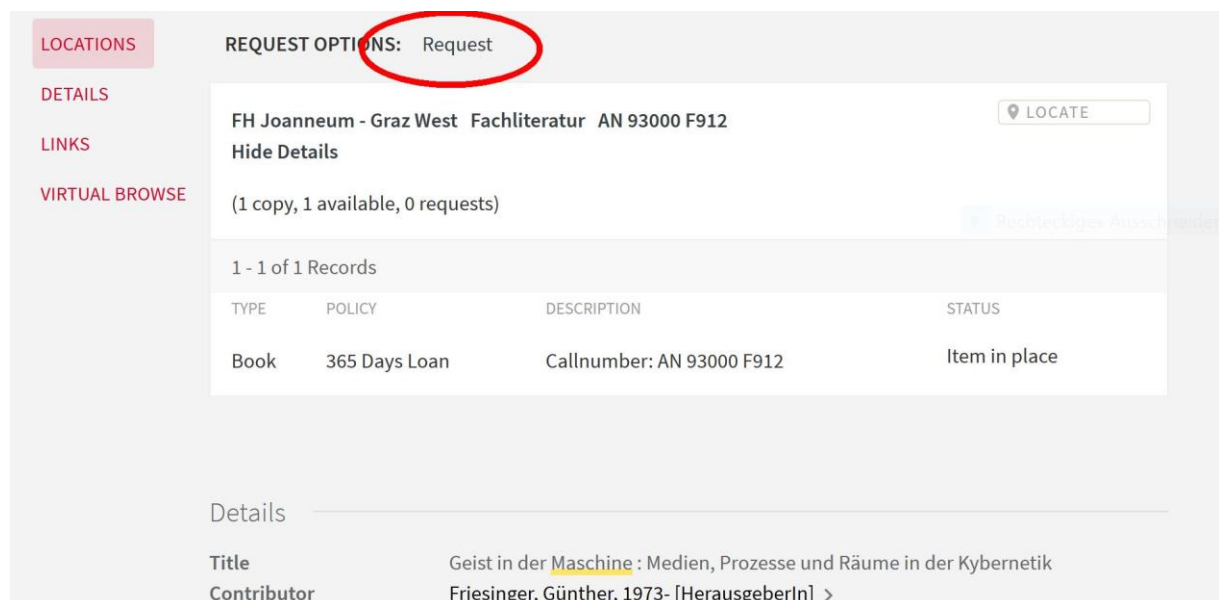


Requesting media directly via the online catalogue
