Introduction Summer Course

This intensive three-week course gives students insight into Dutch culture, the Minerva art community along with its facilities, and the Dutch approach to higher art education. For students who are about to start their Design or Fine Art bachelor programme at Minerva Art Academy, this course is a great preparation for a successful start of their studies. For students from one of our partner universities this course offers them a different perspective on higher art education whilst raising their cultural awareness.

The **Fine Art and Design Introduction summer course** is studio-based, just as the regular Fine Art and Design programmes of Minerva Art Academy. Students will work in a studio environment and will have access to a range of different tutors, facilities, technical workshops, art classes, group discussions, presentations and lectures.

One of the **highlights in the Summer School experience** at Hanze UAS will be the cultural experiences we provide: during your stay, you will get the chance to visit cultural institutions such as the Rijksmuseum, Van Gogh Museum and museum of photography FOAM.

In the **first week** of the academic programme, you will be introduced to each other and each other's works, to Dutch art and design, to the technical workshops and to some highlights Dutch museums have to offer in an excursion to one of the major Dutch cities.

The **second week** has a focus on the studio. You will primarily work in your shared studio space, mainly independently. There will be theory lectures and technical instruction in the workshops. Also, you will make a tour through Groningen and visit the local art scene.

In the **third week**, you will work towards a presentation of all work you made during the course.

You will be based in a studio in the **heart of the Academy**, so, you will see and experience Minerva every-day life.
