



FH JOANNEUM employees and students #standwithukraine and support Ukrainians who have fled to Austria due to the war in their country and are seeking protection here.

The International Relations Department is once again coordinating the measures at FH JOANNEUM and offers, among other things, free German courses for Ukrainians (minimum age 18).

The portfolio of courses ranges from grammar and competence courses (writing, reading/listening, speaking) through to cultural courses, a course on German-language film in the winter semester and seminars offered as part of the intercultural focus R.U.D.I. We also offer courses in business and Austrian German and in academic presentation and writing in the summer semester.

1. Requirements:

- Min. age 18 years
- Online registration (<http://fhj.to/german-courses-ukraine>)
- Acceptance of course regulations: download from <http://fhj.to/german-courses-ukraine>
- Placement test (only required if you are not absolute beginner)

2. Courses in the summer term 2022: Semester course (15 weeks, 2 hours per week per course), Intensive Course (3 weeks, 60 hours) in September and February, special German courses for beginners (A1/1), start end of March/begin of April 2022, date tba

3. Online registration: Following registration you will receive a confirmation by email.

4. Online placement test: If you are new to us and not an absolute beginner, you will receive a link to the mandatory online placement test by email from “virtueller-campus@fh-joanneum.at”. If you do not receive the email, please check your SPAM folder.

5. Personal interview: Once you have completed the online placement test (if necessary), you will be invited to a personal interview.

6. Online course registration (for semester courses only): If you have registered for a semester course, you will be emailed a registration link where you can select the desired course(s) according to the level assigned by us. Please note that places on the course are subject to availability. You will receive the final confirmation of acceptance by email. The course materials required for the start of the semester will be indicated in the email.

7. Course rules: You are required to attend at least 80% of the course units. If you plan to attend further courses, you will have to complete the course(s) successfully. If you are no longer able to attend a course or courses for personal reasons, you must notify us immediately by email to daf@fh-joanneum.at. Otherwise, you will no longer be entitled to attend any other courses at FH JOANNEUM.

8. Course certificate/confirmation: Once you have successfully completed the course, you will receive an email indicating when you can collect your certificate/confirmation from our office.
